70 gramos de agua 20 gramos de gelatina neutra en polvo 2 gramos de glicerina vegetal

> PEAM: el primer paso es pesar todos los ingredientes en una báscula o pesa digital. Ve añadiendo cada uno de los ingredientes en una jarra mezcladora, siguiendo el orden del listado anterior. Mezcla bien todos los ingredientes con la ayuda de una cuchara hasta que no quedon grumos.

COCINAR: a continuación, cocina la receta, añadiendo esta mezcia en una olla y calestando, sin parra de remover. Cocina a fuego medio durante unos minutos, sin que llegue a hervir. VERTER: prepara moddes con diferentes formas

tamados y texturas. Echa la mezcla sobre el molde SECAR: espera a que el biomaterial se seque, de a 3.5 días dependiendo de las condiciones de humedad y temperatura del ambiento. Durante el proceso de sexudo coloca el biomaterial en un lugar seco y ventidado para prevenir la aspacición de molo. Cando condideres que ya está seco prueba a desmoldarlo y estará listo para junar.

A fun graphic novel where Oscar discovers what becoming a father is actually like. Because, as he says, "this is not like what people told you".




